An analog system for digital people

Most of what you would need in an outage lives on a phone that may be dead, or in an account you cannot reach. This is the paper copy. Fill it in once, keep it somewhere everyone can find, and check it twice a year.

Nothing on this sheet is sent anywhere. It is a blank form — we never see what you write on it.

SECTION 1

Your people

Everyone in the household, plus one contact who lives far enough away to still have phone service.

SECTION 2

Where we meet

Two places: one close enough to walk to, one outside the neighbourhood in case you cannot get back.

SECTION 3

Utilities and accounts

The numbers you cannot look up when the power is out — and where the shutoffs are.

Medical

Medications, doses and pharmacy. Worth having on paper if someone else has to fill a prescription for you.
